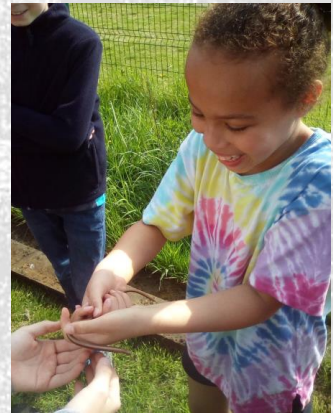




# WE HAD AN UNEXPECTED GUEST VISIT FOREST SCHOOL!

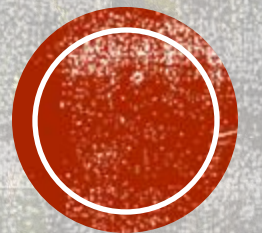

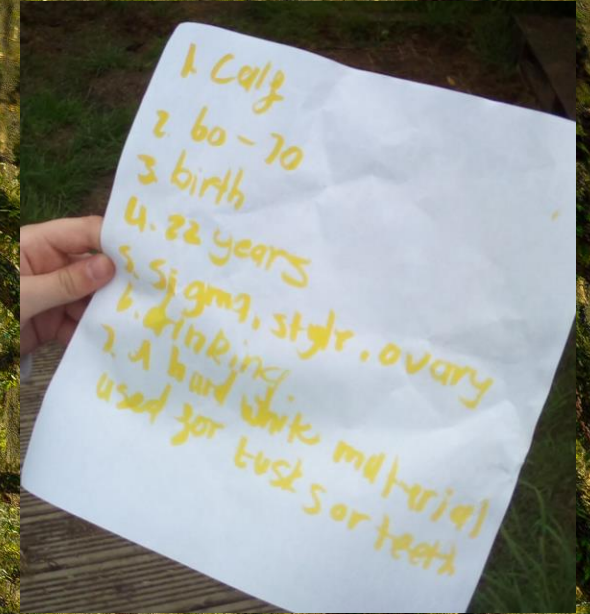




We made our own Green Faces! They all looked amazing!

We enjoyed going on a hunt around the school grounds to answer questions linking to our in-class Discovery Topics.

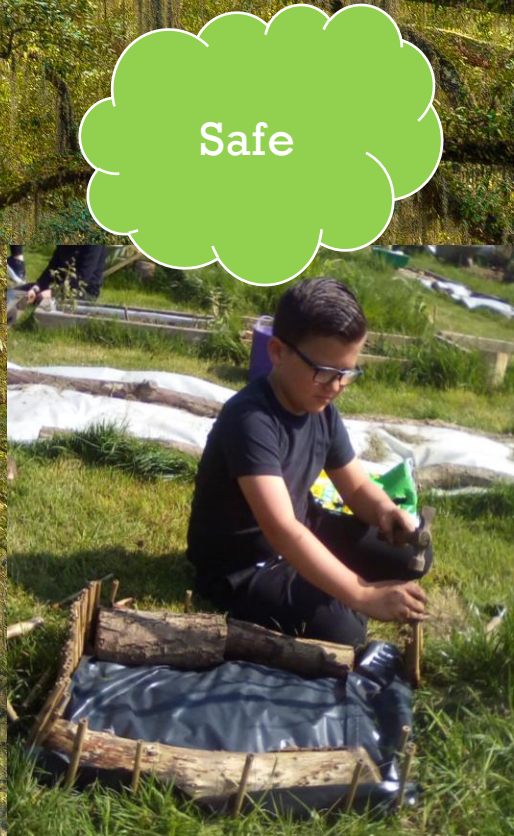

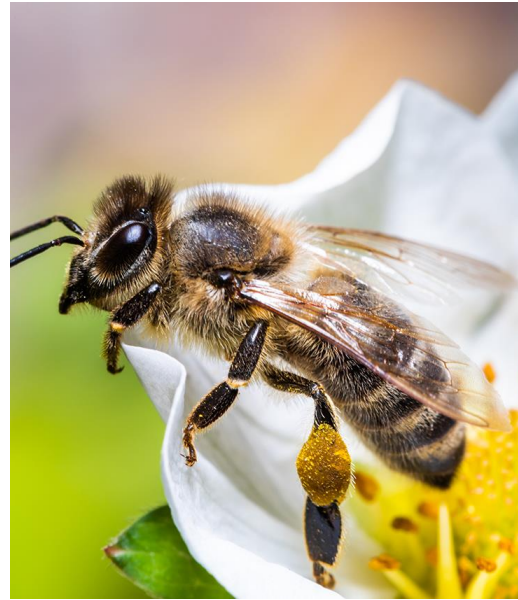
